




Steps	Research Question	Tools
Barriers	Access to spaces to express themselves ✓What are the difficulties that women come across in accessing spaces? ✓What stops women expressing their opinion and being listened to in decision making spaces? Ability to influence change ✓What prevents women from being able to demand changes in their environment? ✓What prevents women to influence decision makers in their community? Emergence of leadership/progression of leadership ✓What obstacles do women who have taken up positions of responsibility face in fulfilling their roles? ✓For women in association what prevents them from rising up the ranks? Key learning from DRC so far

- •The methodology was something that resonated with partners there was a clear appetite to learn participatory facilitation skills.
- •The partner organisation in DRC responded to visual Learning but struggled with abstract reasoning and divergent thinking
- The need for a robust method for conducting analysis
 - The partner in DRC were taught qualitative coding techniques
