The DSAI Research in Action (RIA) team will be hosting a dynamic and interactive session around knowledge sharing across the international development sector in Ireland. The session will engage key stakeholders in a round-table discussion shaped by prominent questions in the Irish development context; what are the drivers for knowledge for academics and practitioners and what are the 'bridging factors' between the two? How healthy is the knowledge infrastructure in Ireland and does it incentivize knowledge sharing? And finally, does our contribution to research and knowledge for development gain sufficient traction to shape policy at both national and international levels?
